

2021-2022 Studio Policies



We will be following all CDC recommendations along with mandates and guidelines set forth by the State of NJ.

Masks are required for all unvaccinated and vaccinated dancers and teachers. Masks with valves, neck gaiters, and bandannas are not permitted. We reserve the right to change this policy at any time.

Class sizes will be limited by age and room size (no more than 7 dancers in Studio 1, and no more than 10 dancers in Studio 2).

Our lobby will be closed to all parents with this exception:

- Our lobby will be open to one parent/guardian per preschool and combo class. Masks are required in the lobby at all times. If you need to bring other children with you, we kindly ask you to wait outside or in your car.

Please do not enter the studio until your teacher arrives at the door to let you in.

Dancers are asked not arrive more than 5 minutes early, and must be picked up within 5 minutes of class ending.

Families must sign our COVID-19 waiver in addition to the studio Rules, Terms, & Conditions.

Studio Procedures

Dancers will be assigned a letter as they enter, which will correspond with a spot for their belongings.

Each studio will have spots spaced 6' apart for distancing.

For ballet class only - spots at barres will be marked and will be at least 6' apart.

Class will be structured to avoid as much contact as possible between dancers as well as teachers. However, we cannot guarantee 6 foot distancing for the duration of class.

Dancers will be asked to sanitize their hands after changing their shoes.

We ask that dancers please use the bathroom before arriving at the studio to keep bathroom use to a minimum.

No food/eating will be permitted in the studio. Water bottles marked with students name only.

Email notifications must be enabled in your parent portal.

Cleaning Protocol

Ballet barres will be disinfected between classes if they are used.

Studio floors and bathrooms will be cleaned and/or disinfected at the end of each night.

Air purifiers with HEPA filters are running in each studio as well as the lobby.

COVID-19 Protocol

If your dancer, or anyone in their household, has been exposed, becomes ill, or is exhibiting any symptoms of COVID-19, your dancer should not enter the studio. They may join their class virtually.

In the event of studio exposure, families will be notified per state guidelines.

All teachers will be following the same protocol as dancers.

In the event the studio needs to close for any length of time due to exposure or state mandates, classes will resume virtually.

We will continue offering Zoom for any dancer that may need to quarantine or who is sick but would like to participate in class. We reserve the right to phase out Zoom/virtual classes at any time.
